

**A BRIEF REPORT ON THE STATUS OF DAMAGES CAUSED BY EARTHQUAKE OF 18.09.2011 AND
ACTION TAKEN AS ON 26.09.2011 BY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION, NAMCHI, SOUTH SIKKIM**

As the earthquake struck at 6:10 p.m on 18/9/11, DC (South) contacted SP, SDMs & DPO immediately at 6:15 p.m. and a control room was set up, manned by ADC (Law & Order) & ADC (Dev) as in-charges, for 24 hours operation till further order. With the help of SP (South), all the Police Stations were alerted and put into action. Respective SDMs and DPO with the Disaster Management Team were sent to have the assessment of all the important places like Solophok, Samdruptse and mainly Namchi Bazaar and surroundings. The Disaster Management team along with DC (South) went to Namchi Bazaar to pacify the people and told them not to panic. At 8:00 p.m., a first review meeting was called at the residence of the DC (South) with all concerned officers of the South District. By 9:30 p.m. with the help of Police wireless system the whole communication was brought under control. Throughout the night all concerns were on high alert for Rescue & Relief Operations. Next morning, at 7a.m, the 2nd review meeting was called at the residence of the DC (South) wherein stocks of situation was taken and necessary directions were given to the respective District Departmental Heads to form a team comprising of officers/ technical officers of the Department and were asked to submit the details of the damages caused by the Quake.

All the relief materials are regularly being provided to the Relief camps and affected persons through BACs and local Panchayats. Necessary steps have been taken for restoration of Relief camps and schools. The Hydro Power Developers have come forward for restoration of roads and setting of temporary sheds to run the above damaged schools and relief camps. After having total control over South District and looking into the severity of the situation in North District, the South District Administration decided to send a team for rescue operation under the leadership of Institute of Himalayan training Academy, Chemchey, South and the team already proceeded for remote areas of North District who will coordinate with the State Control Room in order to provide the ground position/ status of the specifically inaccessible areas of North Sikkim. The district Control room is in regular contact with control rooms of East Dist., Gangtok, West Dist., North Dist., State H.Q and at New Delhi. The necessary communications are also being provided to MHA, New Delhi as and when asked.
